DECLARATION OF LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the health, life, and property of the residents of Zavala County is under an imminent threat of disaster from the human trafficking occurring on our border with Mexico. The ongoing border crisis has resulted in thousands of undocumented aliens pushing our local, state, and federal law enforcement to its limit. This has resulted in residents of Zavala County sustaining property damage, and a concern for the public health and safety of the residents.

WHEREAS, in addition, the public health and safety of the residents of Zavala County is under an imminent threat of disaster from an elevated risk of exposure to unknown variants of COVID-19 resulting from the human trafficking occurring on our border with Mexico. The limited resources of Zavala County cannot adequately furnish the necessary procedures and facilities set forth by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention for the testing and quarantining undocumented aliens who may be infected with unknown variants of COVID-19, or other infectious diseases that residents have not been vaccinated for; and

WHEREAS, the County Judge of Zavala County, Texas, has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to ensure the protection of the health, safety, and welfare of County residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF Zavala County, Texas:

- 1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for Zavala County, Texas, pursuant to Section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code;
- 2. Whereas, pursuant to Texas Government Code Section 418.108, the County Judge and Commissioners Court may enter such orders as may be necessary to protect the safety and welfare of the public during local disaster;
- 3. Whereas, the County Judge and Commissioners of Zavala County establish the disaster order as requested by the Governor of the State of Texas for all Texas Counties with executive orders suspension of Texas laws in response to Covid-19 aimed at protecting the health and safety of Texans and ensuring an effective response to this disaster;
- 4. Whereas, the County Judge and the Commissioners of Zavala County recognize and accept that the Governor is following Sections 418.014, 418.016 and 418.017 of the Local Government Code as an extension of the Disaster and in compliance with all of Governor Abbott's preceding orders to the inception of the initial declaration;
