Notice is hereby given that on Friday, July 24, 2026, the Commissioners Court of Zavala County will hold emergency meeting at 6:00 p.m. at Commissioners Courtroom, 200 E. Uvalde St., Ste. 9, Crystal City, Texas.

The subjects to be discussed are listed on the agenda(s), which are attached to and made a part of this notice.

If during the course of the meeting covered by this notice, the Commissioners Court should determine that a closed or executive meeting or session of the Commissioners Court is required, then such closed or executive meeting or session as authorized by the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code Section 551.001 et. Seq., will be held by the Commissioners Court at the date, hour, and place given in this notice or as soon after the commencement of the meeting covered by this notice as the Commissioners Court may conveniently meet in such closed or executive meeting or session concerning any and all purposes permitted by the Act, including, but not limited to the following sections and purposes:

Texas Government Code Section:

- 551.071 For the purpose of a private consultation with the Commissioners Court's attorney on any or all subjects or matter authorized by law.
- 551.072 For the deliberation regarding real property.
- 551.074 For the purpose of considering the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline or dismissal of a public officer or employee, to hear complaints or charges against a public officer or employee.

Should any final action, final decision, or vote be required in the opinion of the Commissioners Court with regard to any matter considered in such closed or executive meeting or session, then the final action decision, or final vote shall be either

- (a) in the open meeting covered by the Notice upon the reconvening of the public meeting; or
- (b) at the subsequent public meeting of the Commissioners Court upon notice thereof; as the Commissioners Court shall determine.

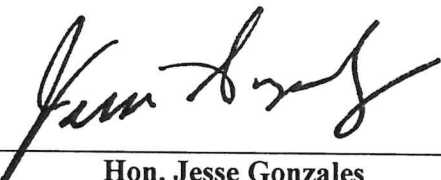

DELIBERATE AND CONSIDER ACTION ON THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:

3. discussion and possible action to approve a Memorandum of Understanding between Uvalde Consolidated Independent School District and Zavala County for the use of the Batesville Gymnasium as a disaster assistant, volunteer intake, and relief center in response to the declared disaster;
4. discussion and possible action to approve a public-interest finding authorizing the removal of disaster-related debris from private property when necessary to protect public health, public safety, and the economic recovery of the community, subject to applicable laws, regulations, right-of-entry agreements, and hold-harmless requirements;
5. discussion and possible action to authorize the Zavala County Judge to appoint necessary personnel, activate and coordinate disaster-relief resources, and establish or operate disaster assistance, volunteer intake, distribution, shelter, and recovery centers in response to the declared disaster;

6. discussion and possible action to adopt, implement, and amend Zavala County's emergency and disaster-response policies, procedures, and administrative measures, with an effective date retroactive to July 12, 2026, to address expenditures, personnel assignments, emergency operations, disaster-relief activities, and recovery efforts associated with the declared disaster;
7. commissioners request for future agenda items
(No action or discussion may occur during this agenda item); and
8. adjourn.

If during the course of the meeting, discussion of any item on the agenda should be held in a closed meeting, the Board will conduct a closed meeting in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, Government Code, Chapter 551, Subchapters D and E, including consultation with counsel under section 551.071 and certain personnel matters under section 551.074. Before any closed meeting is convened, the presiding officer will publicly identify the Section or Sections of the Act authorizing the closed meeting. All final votes, actions, or decisions will be taken in open meeting.
